TITLE: Proclamation Declaring the Month of March 2026 as “Disability Awareness Inclusion Month” in the City of Campbell

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

That the Mayor proclaim the Month of March 2026 as Disability Awareness Inclusion Month in the City of Campbell.

BACKGROUND

The Disability Awareness Council, founded by Kirk Kang and Ethan Kang, works locally with elementary schools to promote disability inclusion, support students of all abilities, and encourage belonging among youth. Through its efforts, the organization also provides adaptive programming opportunities, including inclusive run and music initiatives that celebrate the talents and physical well-being of participants of all ages and abilities.

Disability Inclusion Awareness Month, promoted by The Disability Awareness Council, provides an opportunity to highlight these efforts, recognize the contributions of people with disabilities, and encourages us to commit to accessibility and inclusion.
